Try outs for U10 – U13.

During February, BSC is holding trials for players in the following groups: U10, U11, U12 and U13. These Try-Outs are the first of a series of steps BSC is planning to understand players' strengths and development areas and to form teams for the 2012 season.

The days and dates are as follows:

U10 - 6PM to 7.15PM on Tuesday 7th, 14th and 21st of February

U11 - 7.15PM to 8.30PM on Tuesday 7th, 14th and 21st of February

U12 - 6PM to 7.15PM on Thursday 9th, 16th and 23rd of February

U13 - 7.15PM to 8.30PM on Thursday 9th, 16th and 23rd of February

All try outs are being held at Mentone Girls Secondary College, cnr Charman and Balcombe Roads (grass pitches at rear of school).

Players should attend at least 2 out of 3 trials and ensure they are properly attired with shorts, boots and shin pads and bring drinks. All players must bring own ball size 3 for U10 Size 4 for U11 upward. If you can't attend at least two sessions, please contact your Age Group Coordinator.

Summer skills session for juniors
