Bendigo Bank Goalkick Programme

What is the Bendigo Bank Goalkick Programme about?

Welcome to Soccer - for many of you this will be your child's first experience of the beautiful game. Our aim is to instill in children the basic techniques of soccer and as they develop so too will their confidence, skills and their enjoyment of the game.

Goalkick is a development programme designed to introduce young boys and girls aged 5 to 7 to the game of soccer in a non-competitive and fun environment. Four year olds are eligible as long as they are turning 5 during the season.

Goalkick is run on Sunday mornings for approximately an hour beginning 1st of May. Each session consists of skills and development drills, finishing off with a small-sided game where the kids can practice their new found skills

Our Director Of Coaching has developed a program to ensure that our youngest players learn fundamental soccer skills in a technically correct fashion whilst in a fun and encouraging environment.

Development Training

Our club offers our Goalkick players the opportunity to improve far more rapidly with mid week Development Night training. This training will occur every Wednesday night with 45 minute sessions based on technical progression. This is available ONLY to Beamaris registered Goalkick players and consequently at a heavily subsidised \$5 per session. Please register your interest so we can plan our coaching staff accordingly.

Most clubs don't offer Development Nights for Goalkick players and only give 1 session a week to young players but at Beamaris Soccer Club we feel it's important to give our smallest players the opportunity to develop a solid array of skills.

Coaches

Our Head Coach for Goalkick is also our Director of Football at Beauy - Rob Giabardo. Rob holds both national and international coaching accreditations and has designed our Goalkick programme to his high standards. One of Rob's directives is that there should be 1 coach to a maximum 10 kids thus ensuring your kids get more personal attention. All our coaches are cleared to work with kids and have undergone training supervised by Rob.

Parents

We invite parents to help our coaches during our Goalkick sessions or our optional Development nights. Our experience shows that kids at this young age respond well to parents involvement. No experience is required as our coaches will direct parents on how they can help. We will be also running "Volunteer Coach Training Sessions" prior to the commencement of the Goalkick programme to give parents, who are interested in getting involved, an introductory level session to coaching kids.
